

SHIPPER AGREEMENT SECURITY AND CONSENT TO SCREENING



This Shipping Contract will serve as a mutual agreement between the parties for the purpose of covering a series of air cargo shipments and consent to screening. This agreement is governed by Island Cargo Support's Condition of Carriage. This Security and Consent to Screening Agreement will become effective Seven (7) days from the date of signature by both parties. Air cargo shipments for transport will not be accepted until a signature is obtained and on file 7 days prior to shipping under certain circumstances.

The shipper hereby agrees that they will not tender for transport air cargo that is restricted by the Department of Homeland Security, Transportation Security Administration or any other government agency. Cargo restricted and prohibited for transport includes but is not limited to explosives, incendiaries, or undeclared dangerous goods. The Shipper acknowledges their understanding that all cargo tendered to Island Cargo Support is subject to inspection and screening; and, consents to such inspection and screening from this date forward until such time as revoked in writing by the Shipper. The Shipper hereby understands that Island Cargo Support, pursuant air cargo security regulatory compliance under the code of federal regulations (CFR's) must refuse transportation of cargo on all types of transport aircraft should consent to screen not be given in accordance with Department of Homeland Security and TSA regulations and directives.

The shipper also hereby agrees to maintain possession of the shipment and protect said shipment from tampering until the shipment is tendered to Island Cargo Support. This Shipping Contract is intended to satisfy TSA Security Requirements only and does not bind the parties of this agreement into an obligatory commercial relationship.
